COMMUNITY

Students under this portfolio involve themselves in a wide variety of community events and activities, acting as ambassadors for the school. The College Captains serve on this portfolio along with other interested student leaders.

Typical responsibilities include:

- Hosting College Presentation and Award Evenings
- Participating in Transition events
- Representing the College at Community Engagements
- Hosting Sub-School Assemblies
- Chairing meetings of the SVT



TEACHING & LEARNING

This portfolio sees students investigating issues affecting curricular aspects of the school experience. They develop and assess ideas for improving the teaching and learning programs at the school, including liaison with staff members of the teaching and learning team.

Their duties may include:

- Organising peer tutoring opportunities
- Conducting surveys of student experiences of their education
- Various other teaching and learning related experiences, opportunities and tasks

SOCIAL JUSTICE & INCLUSION



Students raise awareness of social issues impacting students and the broader community and involve themselves in organising activities and events designed to highlight and raise funds for various charitable causes.

Other responsibilities include:

- Charity fundraising events
- Casual Dress Days
- Peer Support
- Raising Awareness of global issues
- Working with disadvantaged students and those needing assistance



ENVIRONMENT

This portfolio sees students tackling environmental and sustainability issues impacting the College and the broader community. Students raise awareness of these issues and organise and conduct events and activities to address these issues.
